### **Re: St Vincent's Parish, Redfern**

Thank you for your correspondence expressing your worries and concerns about renovations at the Redfern Parish Church.

I have drawn these concerns to the attention of Cardinal Pell and he has, in turn, asked the Parish Priest to ensure that the significant heritage and artistic furnishings and fittings in the church, including the mural, be properly restored.

Nevertheless, as you would know, Cardinal Pell is absent in Rome at the moment. I will again draw the concerns expressed by you and other people about Redfern Parish to his attention as soon as he returns.

I believe that the Parish Priest will ensure that the restorations referred to above will be carried out, bearing in mind that the availability of funds may mean that some of the work will take a little time to complete.
